Re: Withdrawal of Registration Statement on Form S-1 (File No. 333-228044) filed by Bionik Laboratories Corp. (the "Registrant")

Pursuant to Rule 477 of the Securities Act of 1933, as amended (the "Securities Act"), the Registrant hereby requests that the Registration Statement on Form S-1, together with all exhibits and amendments thereto (File No. 333-228044), as initially filed by the Registrant with the Securities and Exchange Commission (the "Commission") on October 29, 2018 (the "Registration Statement"), be withdrawn effective immediately. The Registrant is seeking withdrawal of the Registration Statement due to market conditions.
